Membership Category Descriptions

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP: Refers to a for profit organization that delivers services, including professional services such as, but not limited to, law firms, accounting firms, production companies, including the music industry, and well-being professionals (Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Sociologists, Criminologists, Physiotherapists, Massage Therapists and Homeopathic Professions, including Opticians, Optometrists and Ophthalmologists.)

They are registered within the National Capital Region (NCR) and serve within the NCR.

A maximum of two members of the Board of Executives (including its owner, CEO or anyone formally delegated from the organization) may represent the interest of the organization. Each delegate has the right to vote, with a maximum of two (2) votes per organization, during public assemblies.

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP: Refers to an individual that does not represent an organization, who either practices as a professional or has practiced in the past as a professional, including past business professionals as well as retirees under the age of 65. They must reside within the National Capital Region (NCR). Each Individual Member has the right to one (7) vote during public assemblies.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP: Student Memberships refer to any individual who attends a recognized educational institution. Their place of residence must be within the National Capital Region (NCR) either full-time or during their school tenure.
